Airtel Malawi PLC Brief Overview

- Airtel Malawi Limited was incorporated in Malawi under the Malawi Companies Act 1994 as repealed by the Companies Act 2013 as a private Company limited by shares.
- Re-registered as Airtel Malawi PLC on 18th November 2019.
- Listed on the Malawi Stock Exchange on 24th February 2020.
- Connecting > 8 million Customers With unrivalled data, voice solutions, VAS and high speed fixed broadband internet services.
- Airtel's three licences were renewed by the Malawi Communications Regulatory
 Authority (MACRA) in 2024 Application Service Licence, Network Service Licence
 and Network Facilities Service Licence.






Network and Mobile Broadband Coverage Map

- Service Connectivity dependent on Airtel BTS presence.

Major Challenges

- Foreign Exchange sourcing challenge for Capex Projects Currently prioritization is on capacity projects to improve customer experience.
- Infrastructure Damage approx 57% of Airtel's nationwide fibre cuts are due to road networks and the 43% are due to vandalism and sabotage
